Eid al-Adha comes from Arabic word which means "Festival of the sacrifice", also called the Feast of the Sacrifice. Eid al-Adha is the second of two religious holidays celebrated by Muslims worldwide each year. It honors the willingness of Abraham (Ibrahim) to sacrifice his promised son, Ishmael (Ismail), as an act of submission to God's command, before God then intervened to provide Abraham with a lamb to sacrifice instead. The meat from the sacrificed animal is preferred to be divided into three parts. The family retains one third of the share; another third is given to relatives, friends and neighbors; and the remaining third is given to the poor and needy.

In the lunar-based Islamic calendar, Eid al-Adha falls on the 10th day of Dhu al-Hijjah and lasts for three days. In the international calendar, the dates vary from year to year, drifting approximately 11 days earlier each year.

This year, PATRA SK shows its social care by participating in this religious event and donated two cows to the local mosque in North Jakarta. The hand-over ceremony was conducted on 3rd October 2014 located at Masjid Al- Muttaqien, North Jakarta.

We can see the change that from the first time SK plant area from empty area to be one of the largest lube base oil plant in the world.

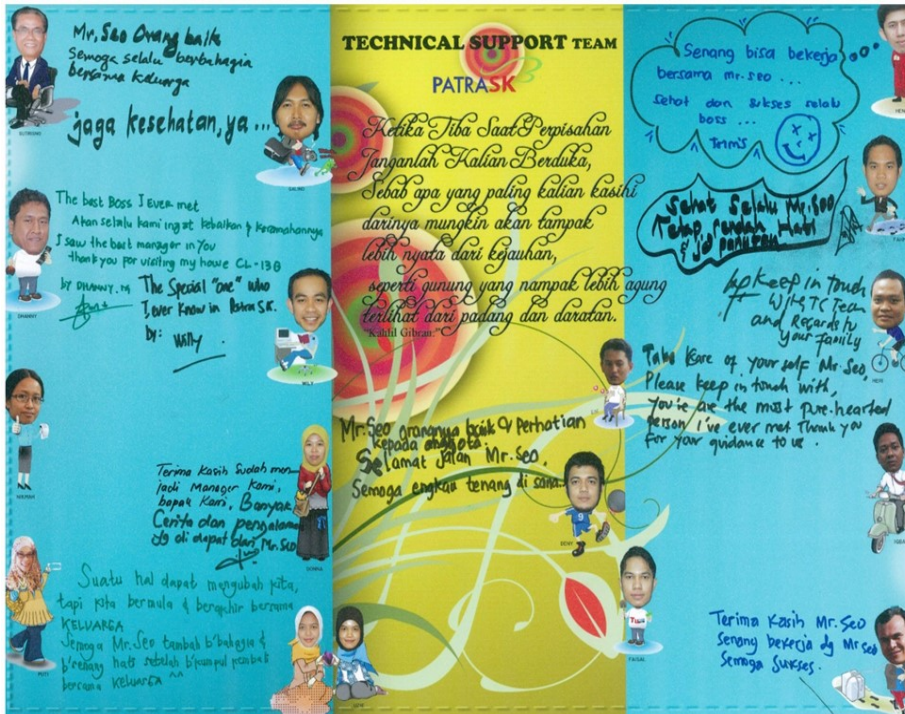

They introduces us to new concept of processes and high performance catalyst based on its global leadership in petroleum and petrochemical processes. In this opportunity they also showed us pilot plant that they had so far to test several operation condition, catalyst performance and now SK Innovation running test their new product of HBO (Heavy Base Oil).

We all are thankful for the company for giving us this opportunity. On 22 October 2014, Patra SK through its CSR programs for Education held drugs seminar for Middle and High School students in Dumai City.
